Media archive.

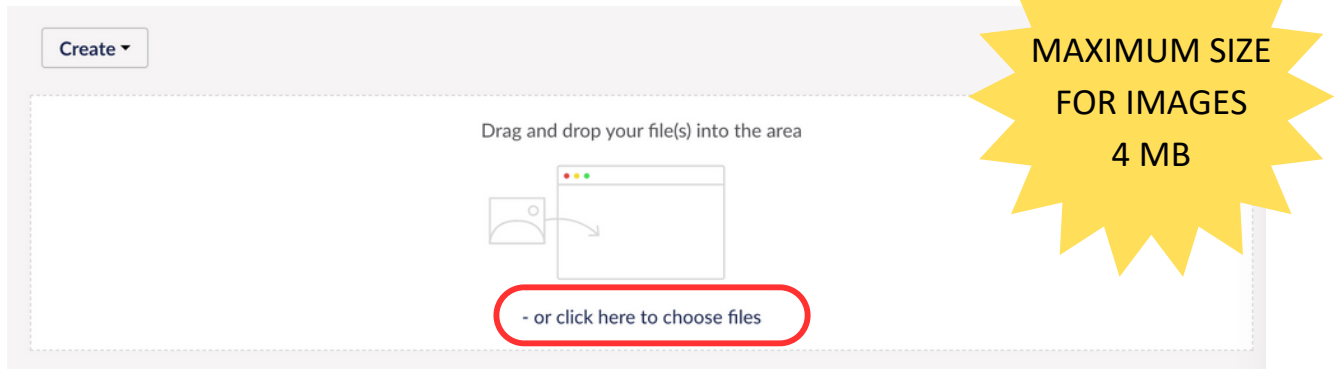


The media archive is used as a storage place for images and documents that need to be used on the website.

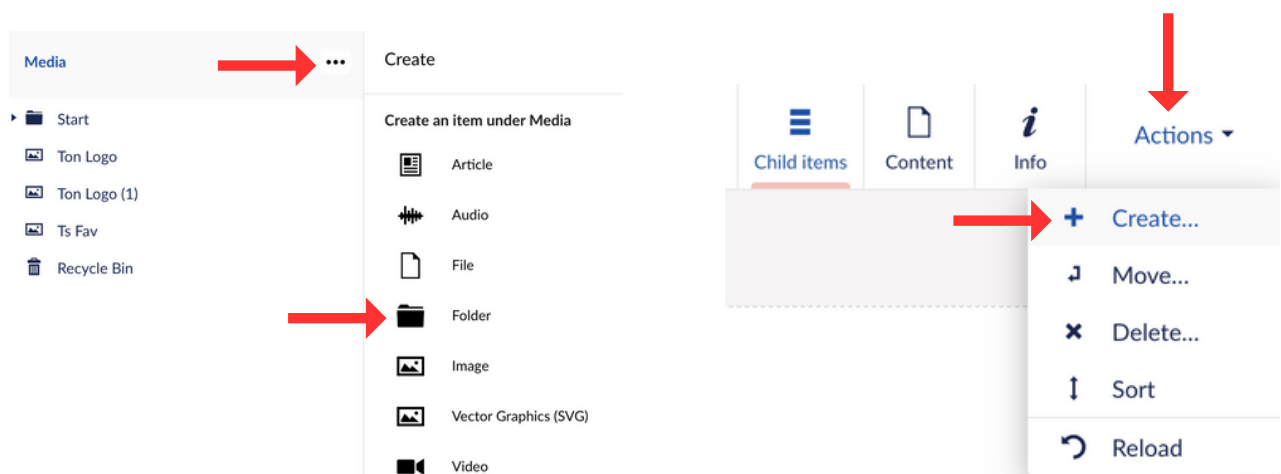
Images and documents are uploaded from your PC, Mac, or drive to the media archive, where they can be organized into folders or directories.

An image/document can be uploaded in two ways. The easy way is to use "Drag and Drop", where you drag and drop an image/document or a folder into the drop zone. Make sure you are in the folder where you want to place the image.

If you need to select multiple files, you can also use the "-or click here to select files" option. A new window will open, and you can now select multiple files at once or an entire folder.



To create a new folder, click on the three dots next to the Media Archive or click on "Actions" and select "Create." Give the folder a name, and it's ready.

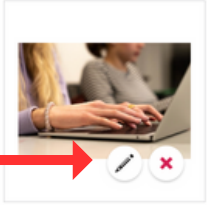


Images can be edited by clicking on the pencil icon when the image is used in a component.

Focal point is defined within your "Media" section.

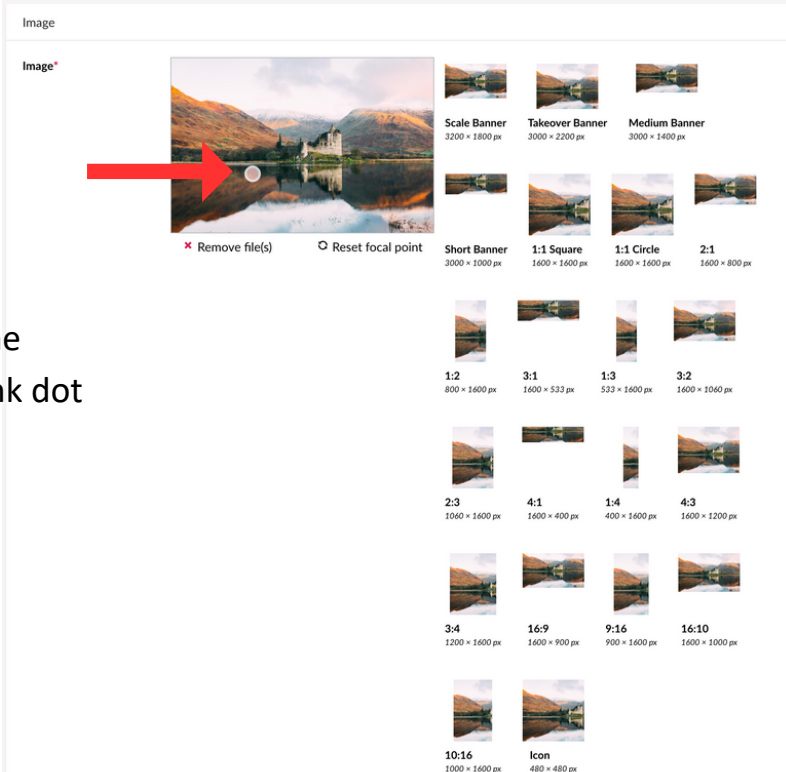
The original image you upload will be displayed within the light window uncropped.
